Dear Provider,

- 1. If you have a claim with dates of service prior to 3/1/2012, which have denied because of no CDC on file, OHCA has notified us that you may submit those for re-processing. However, CDCs should be reported for all appropriate points in time, including admission (CDC 23), treatment plan update (CDC 42) and discharge, even though those points in time might be prior to 3/1/2012. Although the system will allow you to bill services prior to 3/1/2012 without a CDC, the requirement that a CDC be submitted continues to be a requirement. For a list of claims that have paid without an active CDC in place, please go to PICIS and run the report titled "Claims Paid with No CDC on/after 9/26/2011." Please remember, the report is only updated once a week.
- 2. The newest report available in PICIS is titled "Demographics Admission: No Service Check." This report shows you the number of admission by each data element on the CDC.
