Report Description:

Measure: Medication Visits within 14 Days of Admission

The information provided in this report reflects the number of times a medication visit occurred within 14 days of each admission. The monthly reporting period begins 14 days before the first of the month and ends 14 days before the last day of the month. As an example, 'January 2008' reflects the number of admissions between December 17, 2007 and January 17, 2008 that received a medication visit within 14 days of admission. In order to be included, an individual must have received at least one service other than an assessment from contract sources Community Mental Health (01) or Medicaid Services for which DMHSAS Pays Match, Adults (50) within the first month of admission. A medication visit is also counted if it occurs within 30 days prior to admission. Medication visit includes the following procedure codes: 90862, 99212, 99213, 99214, 99215, 99241, 99348.

Exclusion:

1. PACT clients
2. Persons under 18 years of age on the date of service
3. Discharge code 68 (Death) or 65 (Incarcerated) occurs prior to 14 days from admission
Note: if the medication visit takes place prior to discharge, the medication visit is counted
4. Clients with Medicare at admission are excluded, unless a medication visit is reported within 14 days
5. Data that is missing, invalid, or does not fit the criteria

Definitions:

Medication Visit Status: Describes whether or not an a medication visit occurred within fourteen days of admission.

Count: The number of events in each category of medication visit status.

Percent: The number of admissions that were followed by medication visits within 14 days divided by the provider's total number of admissions x 100.

No medication visit within 14 Days: A medication visit did not occur within fourteen days of admission.

Received medication visit within 14 Days: A medication visit did occur with fourteen days of admission.

Report Information:

Frequency of update: Claims are updated weekly. CDCs are updated weekly.

Last updated: Last paid claim is through 8/12/12, CDCs are through 8/14/12.
