Report Description:

This report shows the number and percent of persons based on different demographic variables available on the ODMHSAS ICIS Client Data Core (CDC) form. This report can be used for performance improvement: 1) track and make internal comparisons against expectations/standards, 2) identify opportunities for improvement, 3) determine if reported values fall within norms, and 4) monitor the impact of improvement actions such as training or process/procedure changes.

This report can be helpful in identifying if an agency's demographic distributions are reasonably close to the state's demographic distributions. It is very likely that an individual agency may have clients whose characteristics are not similar to the state. But, this report may be helpful in determining differences in reporting, which may be due to incorrect interpretation of ICIS reporting definitions.

Definitions:

Count: The number of admissions (transaction type 23) and level of care changes (transaction type 40).

% of Total: Number of admissions/level of care changes falling with the measure divided by the total number of admissions/level of care changes.

Difference in Percent: Agency percent minus State percent.

Color coding:

YELLOW: 5% to 9.99% (positive or negative) difference between agency and state score.

RED: 10% (positive or negative) or more difference between agency and state score.

In order to make this report run efficiently, the data are summarized by ODMHSAS on a regular basis. The dates for the statewide admissions/level of care changes are from 07/01/2006 and 06/30/2007. The date the last time the agency information was updated was 08/06/2007. If the last time the agency information was updated is more than two weeks ago, please contact Mark A. Reynolds at (405) 522-3824.

Individuals must be admitted during the time period to be included in this report AND have received at least one service after admission. Data are based on information reported at admission. Counts are duplicated.

Some comparison are not provided, such as county of residence.

State percent may not equal 100% because only the response categories in which the agency has values are shown.
